- 1. Entry Fee: \$100.00 for a 20 X 20 Space or \$150.00 for a 20 X 40 Space. Entry Fee includes all competition categories except DESSERT. There is an additional \$25.00 Fee for this category.
- 2. Awards will be presented for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in 4 categories (Chicken, Ribs, Boston Butts, Sauce) and only one award for the Dessert category. "The People's Choice Award" will be chosen from samples offered between 11 AM to 2 PM on Saturday, April 27th. Visitors will be asked to cast their vote for \$1.00 each, and the team that earns the most "votes" wins. Teams are asked to provide approximately 50 lbs. of meat (any kind) for tasting.

No open pits or holes are permitted. Fires shall not be built on the ground.
- 5. Contestants shall provide all needed equipment and supplies. Safety at this event is paramount. Any unsafe acts or safety issues identified by the Semmes Chamber Rep will be immediately corrected. Failure to follow the directions of the Semmes Chamber Rep may cause removal from the grounds.
